SHAAREI CHESED - OUR FACILITIES AND NEIGHBORHOOD

Our dormitory and classrooms are situated in the scenic Shaarei Chessed neighborhood. (Yerushalayim). The feel of the neighborhood is of old Yerushalayim with a touch of the new. There is an all around feeling of peace and tranquility. We are actually housed in what used to be the home and Yeshiva of HaRav Shmuel Auerbach zt"l.

Our students love being able to walk to the Kosel (25 minutes) as well as to the neighborhoods of Sorotzkin (30 minutes) and Ramat Eshkol (40 minutes)

The building has been remodeled and refurbished to meet our students' needs. The building houses the dormitory, dining room and classrooms. We also have a tree lined beautiful courtyard for the girls to use for leisure and relaxation.

- All rooms are spacious, comfortable and air conditioned.
- We have auxiliary rooms such as an exercise room, computer room and library.
- Meals are provided throughout the school year, including חול המועד, מוצש"ק, מוצש"ק, מוצש"ק. Our students may always sleep in the dorm even on שבת and שבת and שבת.
- Our madrichot also sleep in the dormitory and play an important role as "big sisters" to our students. Mrs. Pepper, our אם הבית lives next door.
- The dormitory will be open from the week of the first day of instruction until a few days after graduation.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM AND FACULTY

Machon Bnos Yehuda offers students a year of comprehensive goal-oriented studies leading to a diploma and teacher certification. Our staff of well respected, highly talented, and experienced teachers are exceptional educators as well as exceptional personal role models. Most of our teachers have been directly influenced by the Torah leaders of the previous generation and impart their timeless messages in a way which is meaningful to today's generation. We are privileged to have among our teachers and lecturers outstanding individuals from the world of the yeshivos and from the field of kiruv. At the end of this brochure, you will find a list of some of our respected and inspiring mechanchim and mechanchos.

Our curriculum covers a wide spectrum of topics. There are intensive studies in חומש, נביא הומש, in-depth analyses of ספרי מוסר ומחשבה, and a broad range of הלכה. These learning experiences are enhanced by lively interactive classroom discussions and meaningful reports. בקיאות in many of the מפרשים are stressed as well. Challenging courses in מפרשים improve textual skills and encourage independent learning. These highly academic courses are complemented by classes which offer השקפה including their practical application of the lessons. Classes in תורת הבית, מירת הלשון, אורחות חיים help prepare the students for life as an אשת חיל weekly schedule enclosed in this brochure.

In addition to our regular classes, we have an **Advanced Track** where students learn from שוב Hebrew speaking Rabbonim and have additional very stimulating and intelectually challenging classes gerared to academically advanced students.

OUR WARM AND NURTURING STAFF

Our staff members place a very strong emphasis on developing warm and lasting relationships with our students. No effort is spared in providing our talmidos with opportunities for individual attention and guidance. Each student is encouraged to develop personal relationships with her teachers. Small groups of students meet in teachers' homes every two or three weeks for lively and thought-provoking discussions on various topics. Our students are also invited to spend Shabbos with our staff members and their families. We continue to be pleased and gratified by the connection which remains long after our girls have left the אמות of Machon Bnos Yehuda. It is not uncommon for our teachers to host a married alumna and her family many years after seminary.

We are especially fortunate to have Mrs. Menucha Pepper as our special אם בית. She is warm, competent, and has years of experience. Mrs. Pepper is responsible for all aspects of our students' emotional and physical well-being. She accompanies students to all non-routine doctor appointments and medical tests, and can always be counted on to host girls for Shabbos. Mrs. Pepper is truly a "mother" for your daughters in their home away from home. Mrs. Pepper's assistant, Mrs. Fox, works to ensure a clean and well-kept dormitory. She also coordinates, with input from our students, a nutritious, well-balanced, and delicious daily menu.

TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM

Particular attention is given to developing teaching skills. Mrs. Nechama (Goldhaber) Feigenbaum (formerly of Bais Yaakov of Boro Park Elementary School and Intensive Seminary), an experienced expert in chinuch, coordinates this program. The Teacher Training program includes courses in Child Psychology, teaching methodology, model lessons and guest lecturers. Specialized programs related to the field of Special Education are also offered. Many of these courses are taught by the well-known educators, Mrs. S. Weyl and Mrs. B. Mannes.

OUR STUDENT BODY

Our vibrant student body consists of approximately 105 high-caliber students. Although each year we receive many applications, we are committed to keeping our student body small. We continue to be successful in maintaining a diverse student body. Over the years, we have had תלמידות from Europe, South Africa, Australia, Great Britain and North and South America. Keeping the number of students relatively small, enables us to limit class size for individualized attention, to house all our students in one dormitory building and to travel together on our tiyulim. This empowers the staff to offer a balance of warm individual attention as well as provide opportunities for our girls to get to know all their seminary peers and to develop friendships with girls from all over the world.

ימי עיון

It is no secret that Machon Bnos Yehuda has excellent ממי עיון. We bring in excellent speakers, many of which have a mesmerizing story to tell. The ימי עיון are enhanced by having a group of girls making a beautiful banner and students' workshop for each topic.

Every month, a Yom Iyun is dedicated to dealing with specific, relevant issues such as:

- הבדלה בין ישראל לעמים
- תפקיד האשה
- בין אדם לחבירו
- נסיונות •
- צניעות
- חשיבות התורה

Some of Eretz Yisroel's greatest rabbonim and educators have graced us with their lessons on these memorable days. We invest much effort in order to enable the students of Machon Bnos Yehuda to hear the words of חיזוק and inspiration from speakers of note, such as HaRav Ganz, Rabbi Neurgershal, Rabbi Perkal, Rav Avichai Cohen. Special emphasis is placed on exposing our students to people who have overcome personal struggles with בטחון and בשחת החיים.

LIVING AND LEARNING

Machon Bnos Yehuda offers its students a unique opportunity for learning outside the classroom. Our students come into contact with many יקירי - extraordinary individuals who are part of the fabric of ירושלים.

These special opportunities have left an indelible impression on our students and have given them a chance to observe first hand many of the ideals that are stressed in Machon Bnos Yehuda. Topics such as קדושת ארץ ישראל הבית היהודי, גדולי ישראל, אחינו כל בית ישראל, חינוך הבנים, נסיונות are presented through walking tours, panel discussions, guest speakers, and Shabbatons in various locations across the width and breadth of ארץ ישראל.

Our monthly walking tours (when and where security permits) focus on the history of ירושלים throughout different epochs. Well-informed, professional tour guides lead our students through the Kosel tunnels and the southern excavations, קבר שמואל הנביא, קבר שמעון הצדיק, קבר שמואל הנביא and many more. The girls appreciate seeing how הסטוריה come alive.

TIYULIM

Full day טיולים provide refreshing breaks in the intensive academic schedule of Machon Bnos Yehuda. We travel to major points of interest in the land of ארץ ישראל, such as ידופה, מצדה, עין גדי and עכו, חיפה, מצדה, עין גדי and ארץ ישראל. These trips, of course, are in addition to providing opportunities to daven at מירון, צפת - and within מירון, בשלים itself. Our students also enjoy overnight trips to the גליל and the גליל. These excursions are a combination of fun and invigorating activities from sunrise hikes to kayaking, and snorkeling in the Red Sea at a rented out beach, as well as providing exposure to the beauty and history of ארצינו הקדשה. All trips are supervised and chaperoned by members of the Machon Bnos Yehudah staff, as well as by security personnel.

INSPIRATIONAL SHABBOSOS

Shabbos in Eretz Yisroel is unique. We strive to enhance our students' experience by providing many varied Shabbos programs. When the security situation permits, we look for opportunities to take the entire Machon Bnos Yehuda student body to different cities, towns and moshavim where we place the girls in remarkable homes for Shabbos – introducing them to אנשי מעלה, exceptional people with unique personalities and histories. Some of our Shabbosos include visiting בני ברק where they see the houses of Rav Steinman zt"l and Rav Michel Yehudah Lefkowitz zt"l. They hear speeches from neighbors of the great gedolim in בני ברק and daven in Ponovez and Ledermans. We go to אפת where we also emphasize the history and the Gedolei Yisroel who lived there. These are just a few examples of our many out Shabbosos.

In addition, during the course of the year we run Dormitory Shabbosos. Our students are encouraged to cook, bake, and prepare divrei Torah for these special Shabbosos. We have seen how this promotes achdus and a special school spirit of cooperation and camaraderie.

All other Shabbosos during the year are "optional." Our students may either remain in the dorm if they choose, where they will be provided with catered seudos or they may make their own arrangements to spend Shabbos with relatives or friends. Students are required to inform the הנהלה as to where they plan to spend Shabbos. The הנהלה will then make sure that each one of our students' Shabbos plans are appropriate and secure.

EXTRA CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

The year spent in Machon Bnos Yehuda includes a wide variety of extracurricular activities, which add a unique dimension to the seminary experience.

- **Chagigos:** For the Yomim Tovim, our talmidos plan and organize chagigos with appropriate themes, menus, decorations and self-developed programs.
- **Melava Malka:** We also have thematic Melava Malkas with very interesting programs where besides having a seudah, we have an interesting activity.
- Musical Performance: During חודש טבת, Machon Bnos Yehuda presents a musical perfor-

mance, for women and girls. Our students work together to inspire our audiences through the artistic medium of song, dance, drama and art.

• This year we have added a weekly activity such as exercising, baking, painting, etc. to give the girls an opportunity to refresh themselves.

The feeling of working in cooperation with others, while using one's individual strengths and talents to benefit others is an intensely fulfilling experience.

DISCUSSION GROUPS

The teachers and students meet in small groups once every two weeks. This is an opportunity for the girls to discuss topics that are on their minds and to openly discuss any hashkafa topics they may want to discuss.

This also gives the girls a chance to develop a personal קשר with the teacher and for the teacher to get to know the girls more personally.

ELECTIVES

Throughout the years the students of Machon Bnos Yehuda were offered our well-known Night and Electives classes that the girls enjoy attending. These classes are "לשמה" – no exams or homework. This year, the topics of our Night Classes are:

- חינוך על פי תורה Mrs. Mannes
- יסודות האמונה Rabbi Kahane
- השקפה Rabbi Perkal

For the second semester, our students will be offered a course on יסודות, bringing all the יסודות to a practical level. This elective course will be taught by Mrs. S. Finkel (Ausband).

CONSTANT COMMUNICATION

From time to time, Machon Bnos Yehuda will send home a Newsletter detailing some of the activities and projects the girls experience throughout their stay in Eretz Yisroel.

A detailed monthly calendar keeps our students informed of all טיולים, Shabbosos, ימי עיון, "Living and Learning" and any other special activities that will take place over the course of the month.

Copies of our in-house monthly calendar are also sent home so our parents can get a feeling of the special year that their daughters are experiencing.

SECURITY

We, at Machon Bnos Yehuda, sympathize with and understand your concerns regarding the security situation in Eretz Yisroel. We would, therefore, like to reassure you of the following:

Machon Bnos Yehuda only visits places in Eretz Yisroel that are considered safe. All of our trips follow the security guidelines communicated to the Administration by the Ministries of Defense, Education and Culture and Tourism. Armed soldiers (frum and married) are hired to accompany the seminary on all trips.

The hanhalah of Machon Bnos Yehuda will describe the security situation in Eretz Yisroel to all of our students upon their arrival and will advise them of all precautions they must take (including in the most unexpected circumstances) throughout their stay in Eretz Yisroel. Our students will also receive specific guidelines as to where they may or may not go during their free time.

During periods of tension, the school administration reserves the right to restrict travel anywhere deemed unsafe. In general, students are not allowed to leave Yerushalayim during the week (except for a simcha, with permission). When a student makes arrangements to leave Yerushalayim for Shabbos, she must get explicit permission in advance. It is forbidden for any student to go to a city beyond the "Green Line" unless she has parental permission.

Remember: All these measures are meant to create a sense of security for both our students and their parents and are not meant to cause alarm.

ACCEPTANCE AND TUITION

Notification of acceptance to Machon Bnos Yehuda will be sent by mail only.

The tuition for the 2024-2025 academic year will be \$28,000, excluding airfare, application fee and mandatory medical coverage. Tuition covers the cost of classroom instruction, room and board, school sponsored trips and Hakaras Yerushalayim programs.

Upon acceptance to Machon Bnos Yehuda, a \$7,00.00 **non-refundable deposit** and three post-dated checks covering the balance of tuition are required. The deposit will be credited towards your tuition.

The fee for application is \$150.00. Please attach this fee to your application. This fee is non-refundable.

All Canadian students must add \$30.00 to each check. The additional \$30.00 charge per check is to cover bank fees. To avoid this additional charge, each check may be replaced with a wire transfer directly wired to our bank or by payment with a credit card. All European students' tuition payments must be wired directly to our bank or paid by Visa or MasterCard. A form is enclosed with detailed information.

PAYMENT PLANS, SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

The Machon Bnos Yehuda policy is to receive all Payments before January 1, 2025. If your financial circumstance requires a payment plan, please speak with Rabbi Akiva Bak in our New Jersey office, 732-813-3230 Ext. 2.

Machon Bnos Yehuda offers scholarships to applicants who are in financial need. We are especially committed to helping large families and those students whose parents work in the Rabbanus or chinuch related fields. The Machon Bnos Yehuda Scholarships are distributed on a first-come-first serve basis. If you would like additional information regarding our in-house scholarship programs, please feel free to contact Rabbi Akiva Bak.

United States Federal and State financial aid is sometimes available. The current 2023-2024 maximum PELL (Federal) grant is \$5,730.00; the current maximum TAP grant (for New York state residents only) is \$5,165.00. Additional information will be sent with the acceptance notification.

Machon Bnos Yehuda is currently affiliated with the following colleges: Touro (PELL and TAP for NY residents) and its affiliates in Chicago (HTC) and Los Angeles, TTI (Raizel Reit) Eastwick College (PELL and TAG for NJ residents) and WITS in Baltimore (PELL and State grant for MD residents). College credits are also given through Maalot Israel.

Acceptance to Machon Bnos Yehuda does not guarantee acceptance to these colleges.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Completed application form.
- High school transcripts for 9th, 10th, and 11th grades including both Limudei Kodesh and Limudei Chol.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Four passport photographs with the applicant's name on the back of each photo. Attach one photograph to the application itself.
- A non-refundable application fee of \$150.00 made payable to Machon Bnos Yehuda.

Unfortunately, we cannot process incomplete applications. Submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance. Please remember to keep a copy of your application and all forms mailed to our New Jersey office.
